## **LEGO ROBOTICS:** (September – December)

Students will build, program, test and compete with robots by Lego Education. Through the *First Lego League* program, the student team will prepare for a regional competition. Club meets once a week after school. Look for flyers posted on campus.

## **SCIENCE:** (January – March)

Through the Science Olympiad program, students learn about and compete in science subjects of their choice. Last year's student team had a great experience at the State competition held in Cheney, WA at Eastern Washington University.

## **DRAMA:** Tuesdays KJH cafeteria (Sept – March)
